## 2012 VAGF Member Show

**ELIGIBILITY AND CONDITIONS:** The VAGF 2012 Fall Member Show is open to all members of VAGF.

**FEES:** Membership dues must be current (paid in 2012) to participate in the 2012 Member Show. No additional fees are required. Member forms are available at [www.vagf.org](http://www.vagf.org).

**ENTRIES:** Up to two (2) entries of original work accepted per member. Maximum size (with frame) is 60" in any direction. *All work must be the original concept of the artist. No copies, reproductions or giclee prints.*

Entries must be completely prepared for secure installation, with wire on the back.

Wire should be approximately  $\frac{1}{4}$  from the top of the frame, *with the wire taut*, due to the hanging system at FDC. No saw-tooth hangers accepted. Neutral colored mats are preferred for framed works. Entries that are not properly framed or have no wire for hanging, will NOT be accepted into the show. Gallery wrapped canvas acceptable with painted edges. 3-D works should be ready to display. The artist is responsible for providing secure display equipment, when necessary.

**AWARDS:** There will be at least one People's Choice Award given for this exhibit. The winner will be announced after the show closes.

**ENTRY PROCEDURES:** Each artist must sign the entry form agreement (separate document), and must attach an identification label to the back of each art work when delivering the work.

**SUBMISSIONS DEADLINE & DELIVERY:** Hand delivery of entries will be accepted on Sunday, January 29 from 1:00 - 3:00 PM. The show will be hung that day, so **NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED**. If you are not able to submit your work on 1/29, then please arrange to submit your work *early* through the Exhibit coordinator.

**PICK UP:** Each artist is responsible for picking up their art work on Monday, March 5 or Tuesday, March 6 during FDC Regular Business Hours, or at the member meeting on Tuesday, March 6 at 7pm. **You must check your work out in the front office.** You will be asked to sign your work out of our register. If you are sending someone else to pick up your art, make a note when you register or let us know in advance of pick up.  
**Art work not picked up by**

**these dates will be charged \$5/day storage fee.** No early removal of art is allowed.

**SALES:** Prospective sales will be referred to the artist. VAGF requests a 20% commission for each sale generated during the exhibition, and Frisco Arts requests 5%, for a total of 25%.

**LOCATION:** Drop off , pick up, the exhibit and artists reception will be at The Art Gallery at Frisco Discovery Center, 8004 N. Dallas Parkway, Frisco, TX 75034.

**LIABILITY:** All care will be taken to ensure the safety of the artwork while on exhibit. However, the Visual Arts Guild of Frisco, Frisco Arts and the City of Frisco assume no responsibility for loss or damage for any reason or cause.
